Let's start with the basics: **what is sublimation really?** Simply put, it's a special printing technique that allows you to transfer any image - photo, graphic, text - to specially prepared surfaces (such as mugs) in a permanent and extremely vivid way. This is no ordinary pasting or painting. It's real magic that makes the print become **part of the object itself**.

Imagine that the ink, which is normally liquid, turns directly into a gas in the sublimation process (sublimates!), and then penetrates the mug's coating under high temperature and pressure. When the mug cools down, the ink returns to its solid state again, but this time it is already permanently "trapped" in the structure of the material. This is why sublimation printing is so **resistant to washing, fading or scratching**. You can't feel it under your finger, it's not convex - it just blends perfectly into the surface.

1. Incredible durability and resistance: This is its biggest advantage! You can wash sublimation-printed mugs in the dishwasher and use them in the microwave without any worries.

The print will not fade, crack or rub off, even after many years of intensive use. No more fading designs after a few washes!

- 2. Vibrant and saturated colors: sublimation achieves photographic quality printing. The colors are intense, vivid, and the tonal transitions are smooth. Your photos on the mug will look as good as they do on the monitor, or even better!

## Chapter 1: Sublimation for Beginners - What Is It? Actually Is?

When starting out on the sublimation adventure, it is crucial to understand what the technique. Don't worry, it's not complicated! Let me explain it to you as simply as possible.

#### A simple explanation of sublimation - how does the magic of printing work?

Sublimation is a clever way to transfer an image, photo or graphic from a printed paper directly onto a special object, such as a mug. The magic happens thanks to two key elements: **special sublimation inks** and **high temperature**.

Normally the ink is liquid, right? With sublimation, something unusual happens. When the sublimation ink you printed on special paper is heated to a high temperature (for example, in a mug press), it doesn't become liquid, but immediately turns into **a gas**. This process is what we call **sublimation** (hence the name of the technique!).

This gaseous ink, under the influence of heat and gentle pressure, penetrates deeply into the special polymer coating that the mug is covered with. Think of it as opening up the "pores" of the mug under heat, which allow the gaseous ink to hide in them.

When the cup cools, the "pores" close and the ink returns to its solid state, becoming **a permanent part of the cup's surface**. It is no longer on top, it cannot be scratched off or washed off, because it is **penetrated into the structure of the material**. This is why prints sublimation prints are so incredibly **durable**, **dishwasher-safe and resistant to sunlight** that would fade them.

#### To summarize:

- 1. You print the graphic with special sublimation ink on special sublimation paper.
- 2. You apply the print to the **sublimation mug** and place it in a **mug press**.
- 3. The high **temperature** and **pressure** make the ink from the paper turn into a gas and penetrate the surface of the mug.
- 4. Once cooled, the ink becomes a permanent part of the mug, and the print is **indestructible** and has **vivid colors**.
